Hello once again,

Even with all the rain and warm temperatures, cross country skiing is still alive at Whaleback Nordic:

Whalebackers at the Provincials

Congratulation to Sam Parsons, Isaac Blundon and Claire St. Croix who skied at the Provincials hosted by Aurora Nordic, St. Anthony. On Saturday, Claire placed 2nd in the 5.0 km classic, Sam placed 4th in the 2.5 classic and Isaac placed 2nd in the 5.0km classic. Great performance by all. Free style results were not available at press time.

Trail Conditions

Today, I decided to hit the trails to determine their status. If you're still interested in going for a ski, please note the following:

Foxtrot: In excellent condition. Rating - 10/10

Ravin's Ridge: In good condition. Be careful on the downhill portion of the Whales Hump, the bottom of the Whale's Hump is collapsed on the right side. However, is skiable. Rating - 8/10

Snowy Owl: In good condition. There are small sections collapsed and small cracks in the base but is skiable. There is a hole in the classic track about 1.0km in the trail. Rating - 7/10

Braveheart: In good condition. Rating - 8.5/10

Oliver's Twist: In good condition. Rating - 8.5/10

Rendezvous: fair-good condition. Portions of the trail have collapsed...especially the left side. Rating - 7.0/10

Abby Road: Good condition...however, the trail is collapsed about 100 m from where it joins RR. Abby Road is a nice ski...the only concern is the 2 metres where I indicated the trail is collapsed. Rating - 7/10

Deadly Descent: No report.

Hayes Hump: No Report...looks soft.

Beaver Tail Flat: No Report.

Other observations:

- I had no problem skiing the trails...never had to stop once to seriously maneuver around an area of concern. Great day skiing...trails mentioned above are an enjoyable ski
- There are no washouts, culverts are doing their job.
